



Transurethral Microwave Therapy for BPH

Pre-op:

You will generally be given medications for pain and antibiotics in preparation for your TUMT procedure. Your doctor and medical assistant will give you specific instructions for these medications. You do not need to fast for this procedure. In fact, it is better to have a light meal before undergoing to procedure, as this may make it less likely that you will experience weakness or light-headedness.

Post-op:

You will be able to return home soon after the procedure is completed. The whole process should take about 1-2 hours. You will likely wear a bladder catheter for anywhere from 5-10 days depending on your doctor's orders. You will be given instructions on how to care for the catheter.
